Think about a Codicil.

The Codicil, as you probably know, is an appendage to a will that adds to or modifies something in a will. For example, if you want to change the personal representative named in your will, you can do so with a codicil. If you want to add the name of someone to receive a bequest, you can use a codicil. If you want to delete the name of someone, a codicil will work fine.

1. **Codicils are effective.**
They do the job. They are just as legally binding as the main document. Some of our friends may want to add Gabriel Richard High School Educational Foundation to their wills and others may want to adjust the amount they previously decided on. In either case, this can be done effectively through a codicil.
2. **Codicils are easy and inexpensive.**
Adding a codicil is considerably less expensive than redrafting an entire will. The codicil presents an easy way to include the GR Leadership Foundation in an estate plan.
